CURTIS FAMILY NEW MEXICO SCHOLARSHIP

Paul Curtis' (President/Owner) step-mother, Lula Belle Currant Walker Curtis, raised Paul and his siblings from the time Paul was three due to the death of his birth mother in a motor vehicle accident. The driver of the other vehicle was under the influence. Lula Belle was born in New Mexico, raised in White Oaks, and was one of 11 children born to ranchers in that area. The family epitomized hard work, ruggedness, independence, grit and determination. She passed that along to her step-children. Located in Lincoln County, White Oaks is now considered a ghost town, but continues to hold a special bond for the Curtis Family as does the state of New Mexico. In memory of Lula Belle and their continued support to the State of New Mexico, the Curtis Family offers this scholarship to a member of New Mexico's Fire Service.

This scholarship may be used to cover the cost of registration fee, hotel, travel and other expenses related to training. Scholarship awardees must submit receipts upon completion of training, in order to be reimbursed by the NM Fire Chiefs Association. Applicant must submit copy of training description and registration form for intended training/conference. This Scholarship is non-transferrable. Applicant must be a current member of New Mexico Fire Service (City, County, Paid or Volunteer). Scholarship may be awarded for full amount \$1500.00 or Partial amount of not less than \$750.00, if more than one applicant is awarded. Applicants will be notified within two weeks of application submission.
